GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The preamble to the contract shall be considered an integral part and shall be read as a single unit.
- 2. This contract shall be binding upon the Parties at the time of its signature. The Second Party shall not be entitled to withdraw or cancel their participation, after signing it under any circumstances. In the event of its withdrawal, the contract shall be deemed to be valid and the Second Party shall be obliged to bear the remaining amount of the contract.
- 3. The second party undertakes to pay 50% of the value of the contract at the time of signature and the remaining 50% 20 days before the opening of the exhibition.
- 4. The second party may not sell any part of their booked rental area to any third party of the exhibitors unless the written consent of the first party is obtained. Otherwise, the first party has the right to terminate the contract, re-sell the space mentioned in the contract.
- 5. The First Party undertakes to hand over the booked area to the Second Party two days prior to the opening of the Exhibition.
- 6. The First Party shall not be liable for any loss suffered by the Second Party as a result of the intrusion or theft of the goods offered during, before or after the offer period.
- 7. The cost of all services not provided for in the contract shall be paid by the Second Party.
- 8. The Second Party is responsible for transporting and delivering the materials presented to and from the specified platform.
- 9. The Second Party shall declare its participation in the Exhibition of its own accord and on its own initiative. This contract shall not constitute an oral or written promise by the First Party at the level or success of the Exhibition.
- 10. The Second Party undertakes to comply with the items presented and approved by the First Party, and in failing to comply with this, it undertakes and commits to remove the Second Party from the Exhibition immediately if the First Party so requests.
- 11. This contract shall commence from the date of its signature and end at the end of the exhibition.
- 12. If a dispute arises as to, or due to, or as a result of this contract, the dispute shall be referred to the Jordanian Arbitration in accordance with the Jordanian Arbitration Law.







- 13. This contract consists of fourteen items and two original copies, each one holding one original copy.
- 14. Pulse International for Organizing Exhibitions and Conferences (First Party) has the right to cancel any contract with any participant in the exhibition without reference to it, if necessary.
- 15. **Breach of contract and withdrawal by exhibitor.** Without prejudice to the rights and remedies of the organizers in respect of any breach of contract on the part of the exhibitor, the organisers may at their discretion allow the exhibitor to withdraw from the exhibition subject to the following conditions:

 a) The exhibitor must give written notice to the organisers that he/she desires to withdraw and if the organizers allow such a withdrawal, they will notify the exhibitor of their decision in writing.
 - b) Any such notification by the organizer to the exhibitor will constitute a cancellation of the contract subject to the payment by the exhibitor to the organizers of a consideration for the release from the contract.
 - c) The amount of such payment will be specified in the organizer's notification to the exhibitor and will be the proportion of the space rental as specified in the table below. The 1" column below refers to the date upon which the organizers receive the notification from the exhibitor.

Date of receipt of notice of withdrawal More than 90 days before the exhibition

<u>Proportion of space rental payable %</u> Deposit forfeitable

d) Upon payment of such an amount to the organisers, the exhibitor (credit being given to the organiser for the entire rental already paid by the exhibitor) the contract shall be cancelled and neither party shall have any further claim against the other.
